Question 1

We note that Expressions of Interest (EOIs) shall not exceed 50 pages (as mentioned on p.6 of the Request for Expressions of Interest (REOI) document available at: <https://www.andsa.md/en/tendere-internationale/122-contract-rsp-cs-m5-01-2026-servicii-de-consultan-pentru-supervizarea-lucr-rilor-de-reabilitare-drumului-m5-frontiera-cu-ucraina-criva-b-l-chi-u-tiraspol-frontiera-cu-ucraina-lot-iv-km-103/>).

That being said, we would like to ask as to whether there is a maximum number of experiences (project references) that can be presented, since we have spotted that in the shared form for Consultant's Experience (Table 2. On p. 4-5 of the REOI, see snapshot below), it is stated "Project No.: ____ of 10". Does this mean a maximum number of 10 project experiences can be put forward for the purpose of the evaluation?

Answer 1

The reference to "Project No. ____ of 10" in Table 2 – Consultant's Experience Form provides the format of the form and does not seek to set a limitation on the number of project references that may be presented. The Consultant may provide detailed information for as many project references as it considers sufficient for demonstrating its relevant experience.

Consultants may also list additional assignments in Table 1 – Consultant's Experience List. There is no prescribed maximum number of assignments that may be listed in Table 1, provided that the overall Expression of Interest remains within the prescribed maximum limit of 50 pages.

For the purposes of evaluation under the "Company Experience" criterion, the Consultant should present sufficient project references to demonstrate compliance with, and the extent of experience relevant to, the applicable sub-criteria, namely "Experience of Consultant in similar assignments" and "Experience of Consultant in similar locations".

The Consultant should use Table 2 to provide the detailed information required for the project references considered most relevant to the above criteria, while additional experience may be listed in Table 1, subject to the 50-page limit.
