This ministry is responsible for the rehabilitation, modernization and expansion of the national road network; establishing a sustainable mechanism for financing the maintenance of public roads, ensuring access to sanitary systems, strengthening the capacity of water supply and sewage service providers, investing in water supply and sanitation infrastructure, and implementing regional land use plans. The National Agency for Road Transport ensures the implementation of public policy documents and national development strategies in the field of road transport, controls and supervises compliance with national and international legislation. The National Road Transport Agency (ANTA) will be responsible for managing the safety of road infrastructure in the Republic of Moldova. A decision to this effect has been approved by the Government on 30th of July 2025. According to the new attributions, ANTA will carry out systematic inspections on the road network, develop analysis reports and formulate recommendations for road administrators on the necessary measures to improve road safety. At the same time, the Agency will ensure the functioning of the National Council for Road Safety, responsible for promoting and coordinating the state's policy in the field of road traffic safety. To support these activities, the structure of the institution will be adjusted by establishing specialized subdivisions and expanding the number of employees. The reorganization will contribute to the development of an efficient management system, aimed at reducing accidents, protecting citizens' lives and aligning with European standards in the field of road safety.

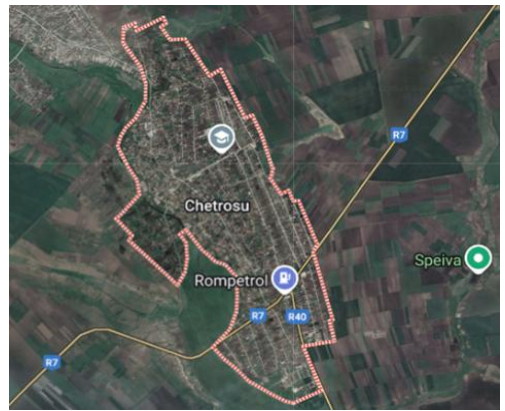

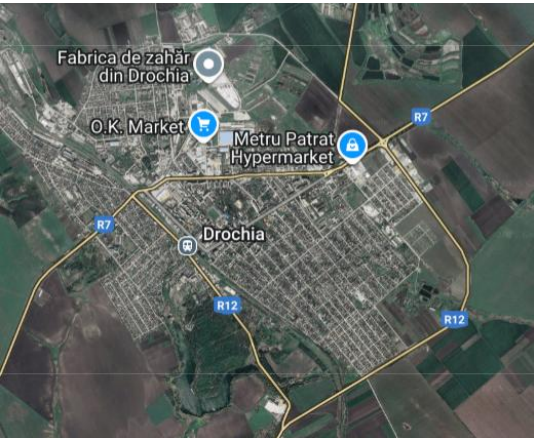

Energocom was founded based on the Decision of the Government of the Republic of Moldova No. 1467 of December 30, 2004 , "in order to ensure the efficient and transparent functioning of the domestic electricity market, promote electricity exports, and increase the investment attractiveness of the objects of the electricity sector". In 2005, the state-owned enterprise Energocom was reorganized into a joint-stock company. By Government Decision No. 885 of 01.11.2017 , SA Energocom was designated as the central electricity supplier, being responsible for the balancing group consisting of thermal power plants and renewable energy producers with eligible producer status. Premier Energy Distribution (SRL) is the largest supplier of electricity in the Republic of Moldova. The company serves more than 947 thousand places of consumption in the center and south of the country. Their role is the distribution and connection of electrical installations, including the presence of pylons.

The commune includes the localities Cureșnița Nouă and Șolcani. The locality is located 14 km from the city of Soroca and 170 km from Chișinău. The population according to the census data from 2024 consists of 1095 people (541 – men, 554 women).  Zgurița is a village in Drochia District, Republic of Moldova with a population according to census data in 2024 of 1,686 people (784 men, 902 women). The direct distance to the city of Drochia is 22 km. The direct distance to the city of Chisinau is 182 km.  Chetrosu is a village in the Drochia district of Moldova. It is considered a village that does not form a commune. The village has an area of about 5.49 square kilometers, with a perimeter of 12.20 km.
